Whether you're into rock and roll, the theatre, poetry, cinema or anything else – Manchester has blazed a trail. This is a place where, if people can't find something that suits them, they have the tenacity, grit and creativity to make it themselves.

In short, Manchester is a remarkable place, and Oxygen is right in the centre of it all. Living here means that you are only a short walk away from Manchester's most creative and interesting areas by Piccadilly, the marina and local school, it's the epicentre of an exciting neighbourhood steeped in rich heritage.

The Northern Quarter.

The Northern Quarter is a sanctuary for Manchester's more creatively-minded people. Located roughly in the area between Piccadilly, Shudehill and Ancoats, it is something completely different from anywhere else in the city, providing a unique flavour which sets Manchester apart.

As with every other part of the city centre, the Northern Quarter was built and grown to encourage industry and enterprise. However, even from its earliest days, historians note that it was also a centre of nightlife and Manchester's dancing culture as early as the 1870s.

Packed with record shops, night clubs, music venues, art galleries and bars, the Northern Quarter is a vibrant creative ecosystem where you can find Manchester's cultural, curious, art and party-loving soul.



Ancoats.

The regeneration of Ancoats has transformed Manchester's original factory-district into a trendy area to live, work and socialise. It's now one of the trendiest and most popular parts of the city, and has been named in the top 50 'coolest neighbourhoods in the world' by TimeOut.

However, despite its transformation into one of Manchester's most desirable neighbourhoods, you can still see glimpses of the aforementioned industrial history via the Ancoats Peeps. These brass spyholes in the walls of buildings let you look onto a scene from the past suspended in time, and serve as a reminder of Manchester's history as a place which changes the world.

Now, Ancoats is centred on Cutting Room Square, home to a fantastic array of bars and restaurants – including the famous Rudy's which serves pizza as good as any in the world and Mana, Manchester's only Michelin Star restaurant. The Square is finished off by the recently-refurbished Hallé St Peter's orchestra space, a stunning building that confirms Ancoats as an area that wouldn't be out of place in any of the great European capitals.



And for when you need to get away...

Oxygen enjoys a prime location that gives easy access to Manchester, the UK and the rest of the world - perfect for those times when you want to take a break and explore somewhere else.

As well as being connected to the rest of the city by the Metrolink tram network – the nearest stop, New Islington, is minutes from Oxygen – Piccadilly Station is only a few minutes away and opens up the rest of the UK. London, Edinburgh, York, the Peak District, the Lake District and more are an easy train ride away – and the capital city will only get closer once the HS2 high speed rail line is completed.

If you want to go further afield to satisfy that wanderlust, Manchester Airport flies to more than 200 destinations and is just a short train journey from Piccadilly Station. As well as weekly flights to Dubai - from operators including Emirates, Qatar and Etihad - there are multiple direct flights every week to Beijing and Hong Kong with Cathay Pacific and Hainan Airlines, and daily flights direct to Singapore with Singapore Airlines. Whether you want to visit San Francisco, Beijing or anywhere in between, living at Oxygen puts you in the perfect place to do it.
